
Jane Smith: Chart Rectification Report

Original Working Time:

18:05 31 July 1979 Bankstown, Australia

Working Rectified Time:

19:25 31 July 1979 Bankstown, Australia



Initial Observations:

In working with the window of time being from 6:00pm to 10:00pm there are three possible rising signs, Aquarius, Pisces and Aries.

By assessing the photographs provided, I felt comfortable in ruling out the Aquarius and Aries rising charts on account of the physical indications that are so often associated with the Ascendant ruler and its placement in the chart.

Physical Associations with the Ascendant:

With Pisces rising, Jupiter is the traditional ruler. It is placed in the fiery sign of Leo and is occidental (rising behind) of the Sun.

William Lilly's views on Jupiter signifying the corporature are as follows:

"...an upright, straight and tall stature... lovely complexion; of an oval or long visage, and it full or fleshy; high forehead... hair soft and a kind of auburn brown, large, deep belly, strong proportioned thighs and legs, his feet long..."

Of Jupiter being occidental:

"A pure and lovely complexion (clear), the stature more short, the hair a light brown or a near dark flaxen (yellow), smooth, bald about the temple or forehead."

By comparison, Saturn would indicate a spare/lean body and one with a crooked gait/frame.

Jupiter's placement in Leo brings emphasis and a certain broadness to the shoulders (mediated by temperate Jupiter) while emphasising a deep, dark yellow, almost brown to the hair, naturally.

For this reason, I felt comfortable proceeding with Pisces rising, which narrowed the window of time to approximately 7:00pm to 9:21pm.

Temperament:

In addition to the physical attributions, based on the information you provided, my impression of your general outlook on life is more expansive and motivated by a certain degree of adventure. While a comprehensive view of the individual involves the analysis of all the planetary placements, this *modus operandi* seems to accompany interests and experiences in life.

General Placements:

Some other placements I felt encouraged by based on the material you provided is that the Moon is having its effect in the 9th, which is often a strong signature for, not just an adventurous, eager spirit, but also one who is of a spiritual nature. Interests like astrology, yoga and spirituality in general are often of importance to people with a luminary in this house.

Mars in the 4th is also something I saw as quite fitting for your description of your relationship with your immediate family. Mars has an affinity with 'cutting'. And its influence being exerted in the 4th House of family/roots is a signature which I have often found in the chart's of people who not only have biological parents who have separated but also experience some degree of strain of difficulty in cultivating a close dynamic. We could obviously go further with this by describing Mars as being indicative of the nature of, not just what is experienced in this area of life, but what needs to be developed through the experiences with family. Some schools of thought would raise the possibility that planets in the 4th can indicate energy which gets repressed or suppressed and needs to be reclaimed. However, for our purposes here, I saw this as fitting.

In a general sense, a loaded 5th House was also encouraging in defining the birth time given your history with pregnancy and children.


Where it comes to the sort of significant moments I expect the horoscope and its activation to speak to, they are ones which leave a lasting impact on our lives, either because these moments radically transform our lives or our view and approach to life is so radically altered that we would 'bracket' passages as being 'before' or 'after' one of these events. It is evident in your biographical narrative that pregnancy and children have had a significant impact.

I would draw attention to the fact that Cancer is on the cusp of the 5th. While benefic Venus is located in the 5th, this time also makes Venus the ruler of the 8th House. From a traditional perspective, Venus is considered to be combust the Sun and in the sign of Leo, which is viewed as a 'barren' sign.

There is much I could say about this, and I would underscore that I wouldn't espouse that the planets have 'caused' the difficulties which you have experienced, rather that they are shining a light on the inherent challenges themselves. While a full discussion is beyond the scope of this report, I raise them on account of the following charts that helped me narrow down the rectified time of 7:25pm.

Specific Examples:

The first specific example I would draw attention to that seems to fit the information which you provided and the time of 7:25pm relates to the miscarriage that you experienced in November 0f 2018. While the exact date wasn't noted, working off a conservative estimated date of 10 November 2018, the following observations struck me as significant:



While I am unsure of how familiar or comfortable you are in working with tri-wheels, I will point out that the inner-most wheel is the rectified birth chart, the middle wheel represents the transiting planets on 10 November 2018 and the outer-most wheel represents your secondary progressions on the same date.


The transiting Sun is conjunct natal Uranus, which is also squaring Jupiter, the ruler of the chart.

Transiting Venus, ruler of the 8th House is in retrograde motion with the Moon, ruler of the 5th House (retrogrades will often tick on and off a sensitive point during the retrograde phase).

The transiting nodal axis, which outside of modern astrology are often connected with significant and/or radical change are in a partile conjunction with 5th House natal Venus.

The progressed Moon is opposite natal Pluto in the 8th House.

Your Solar Return for 2018 (based on 7:25pm) is below:




Notably, Cancer, which rules the 5th House in your natal chart, is rising in the Solar Return with the Moon placed in the 8th House.

While it is not my intention to be morbid, or drag you into unhappy memories, placements such as these do serve as an indication to me that the working rectified time of 7:25pm is a big step towards accuracy.

A little further back in time, the date you note as being the one on which you met your future partner (10 July 2003), using a traditional timing technique known as Annual Profections, your profected Lord of the Year (based on the 7:25pm time) from 2002-2003 was Saturn, which in the rectified birth chart is placed in the 7th House.


In addition to this, your Solar Return for 2003 is below:



While you note that you met him on 10 July, it's often noted that the upcoming Solar Return will begin to take effect anywhere from 1-3 months prior to its official activation. This varies depending on the astrologer, but I would be paying close attention to it within 1 month.

You will note that Capricorn rises in this chart and is angular placed strongly on the 7th House cusp. Such strong, persistent Saturnian themes here.

Finally, I also note the Solar Return (see below) for the year you took your trip to Italy:



Note another strong Saturnian theme, so often linked with partnership throughout all these charts, which is interesting given that you took this trip with your partner. In this chart, Aquarius rises and the ruler is placed in the 9th, exalted in Libra, which would be a warning of 'excess' generally, which most anyone taking a trip abroad could be cautioned about, but is also interesting in that you mentioned 'maxing out the credit card'. It's also worth noting that Jupiter, ruler of the second is somewhat weakened by

the presence of the South Node and in a fairly tight sextile with Uranus, which is placed in the 2nd House.

Conclusion:

I'm fairly comfortable in using this chart as a 'working' rectified chart. I say that because rectification is largely dependent on the information that can be provided. It's somewhat challenging looking back down the corridor of history and trying to specifically cite every date and time something of significance happened.

I commend you in being able to compile the list that you have and am grateful for your candid and open nature (something that I also noted as part of my analysis).

I think this chart fits you, but it is one which I encourage you to work with and continue to refine. **Be especially sensitive to transits and progressions to the angles.** If big events happen and you notice that planets always seem to be a few degrees out, you can likely adjust the time by a few minutes in order to bring that planet to the angle. This tends to work best with slower timing techniques like secondary progressions or solar arcs.
